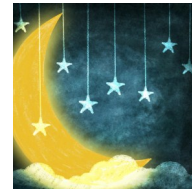

Saturday, October 16; 9am-3pm

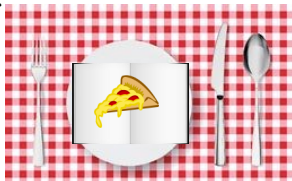

Tweens and Teens Book Tasting

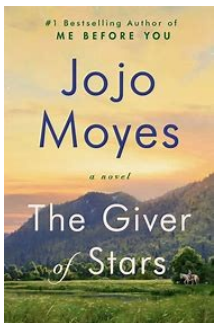
Saturday, October 23; 10:30-12:00pm
