



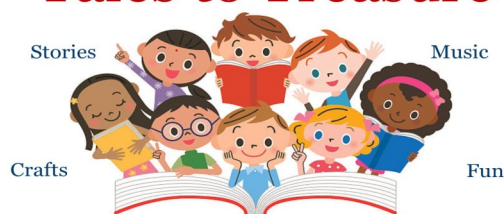

Paint Night: Fall Birch Trees

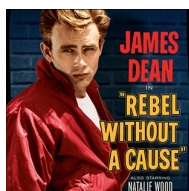
Wednesday, November 6th, 6 -8 p.m.

Medicare & Social Security Help

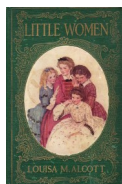
