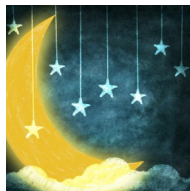

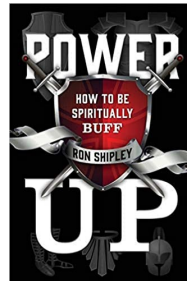
## Labor Day Closure

## Tweens and Teens Game Night

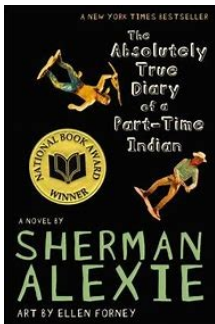
**Wednesday, September 22; 6-7pm**
