Foundation Fitness + is a safe, fun, and effective chair and standing exercise program. This program, developed and taught by Eileen Seegert,




is designed especially for seniors, but would benefit adults of any age. Classes will be limited to 10 participants and offered free of charge. Call the library to sign up!


## <u>Lego Club</u> Monday, August 21; 5:30-6:30pm
