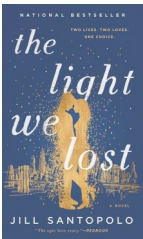

Wednesday, September 11th; 6-7pm

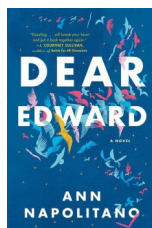
