Come in and pick out a new-to-you Halloween costume, beginning on **Tuesday, October 1st** and continuing through **Wednesday, October 30th**.

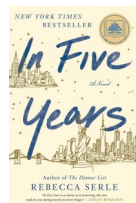


Haunted house Painting Thursday, October 3; 4-6pm

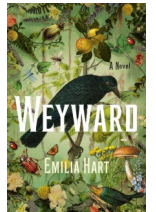

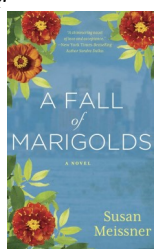
