Thursday, April 3; 4-6pm

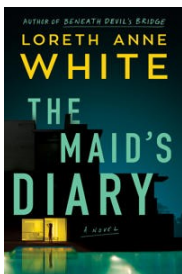

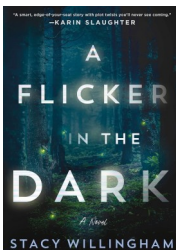
Information and Referral Help for Seniors

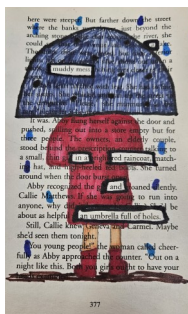


Novel Ideas Book Club
