March 19: Dr. Seuss

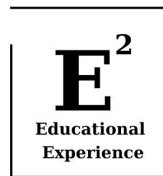

Novel Ideas Book Club

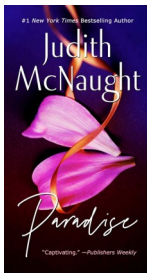
Wednesday, March 26; 2pm-3pm

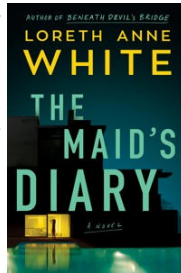


Date Night Book Club

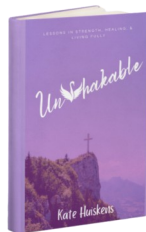

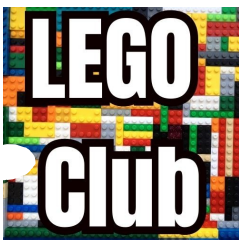
Author Kate Huiskens will be here to share her story with us, answer your questions, and sign copies of her book, “*Unshakable*”.
