

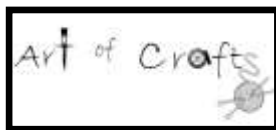

Monday, February 25; 6-7:30 p.m.

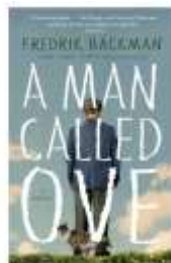
