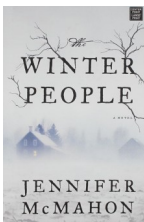

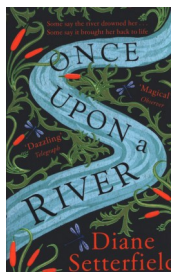

Wednesday, January 28; 2-3pm

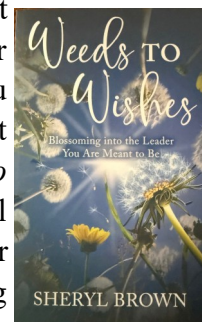
