February 25: Dynamic Dragons

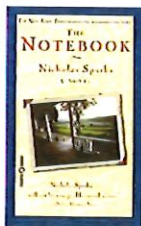
Paper Heart Garland Thursday, February 5; 4-6pm

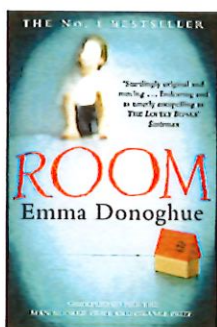
Evergreen Community Library will be **CLOSED** on **Monday, February 16th** in observance of President's Day.
