- April 29: Cluck, Cluck Chickens

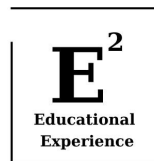


Library Closed

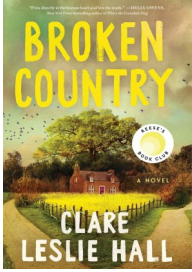

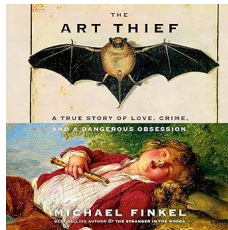
