- May 27: Going on a Picnic

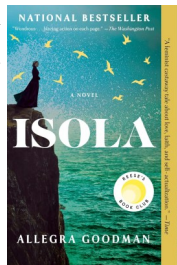

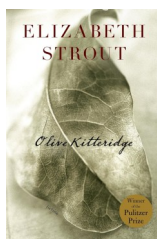
**Date Night Book Club**
