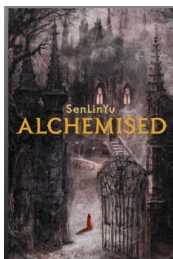
Library Closed

Beginner's Crochet Class

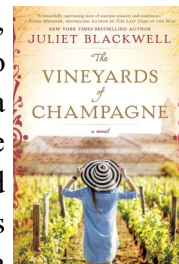
Wednesday, September 30; 5:30-6:30pm
